

## Report on Student Feedback on Curriculum 2023-24

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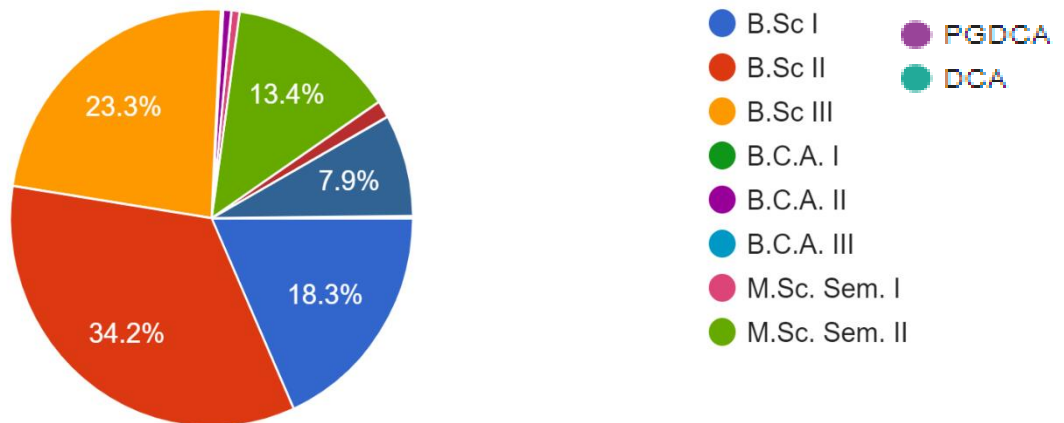
The feedback cell of Govt. N.P.G. College of Science adopted an online procurement of student feedback in the current session 2023-24. A total of 606 responses were generated.

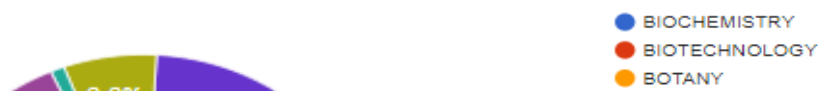

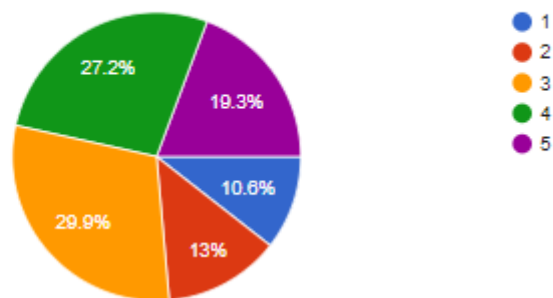

The responses received from students are as follow:

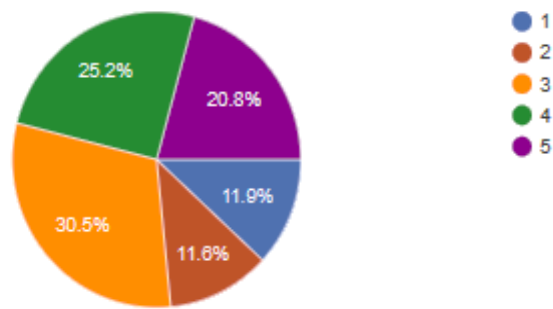
1. Whether your curriculum is increasing your analytical ability?

  - e. 20.8 % of students (126 students) rated it as poor.

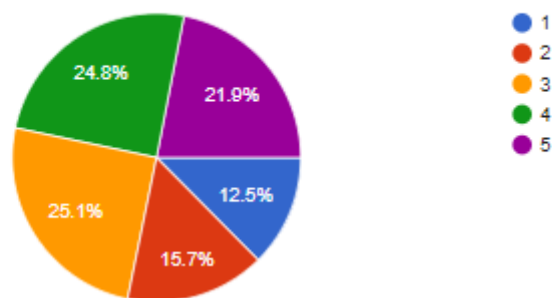

- 12.5 % of students (76 students) rated it as poor.

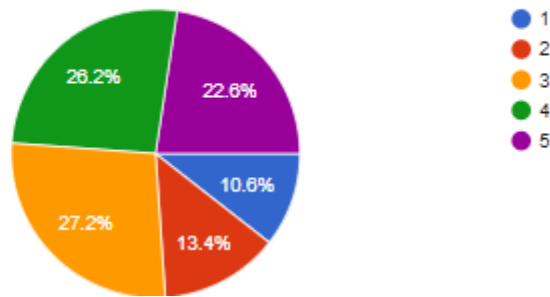

- 10.6% of students (64 students) rated it as poor.

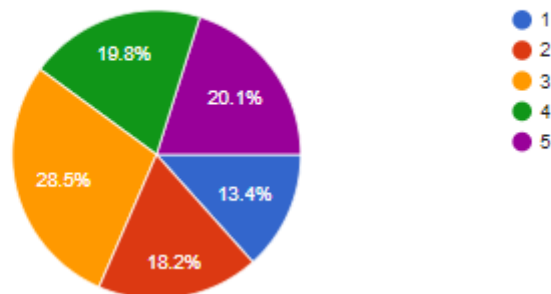

- 13.4% of students (81 students) rated it as poor.

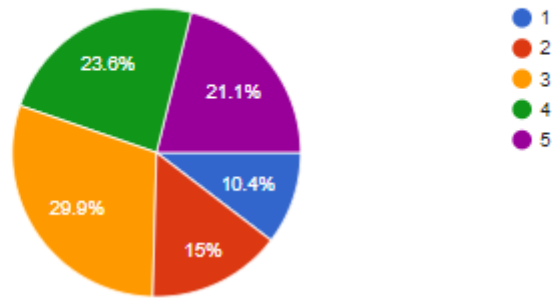

- 10.4% of students (63 students) rated it as poor.

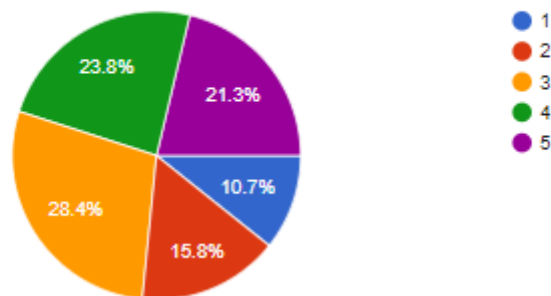











8. Suggestions (If Any)
